### SCOTT AIR FORCE BASE STATISTICS

#### **Population:**

*Total work force: 13,065*

- Active Duty military – 5,753
- Civilians – 5,431
- Air Force Reserve – 1,221
- Air National Guard – 660
- Family Members (Dependants): 7,679
- Retired Military: 14,630

**Total Population:** 35,374

- 25.6 percent of military members live on base
- Housing units: 1,426 family units and 4 dorms for 569 airmen
- Temporary Quarters: 20 units for 455 people

General officers at Scott: 18

- Generals that live on base: 14

Officers:

- Average age: 35 years

## Monetary Value of Scott AFB Resources

- Capital assets worth \$2.5 billion (buildings, real property, land, etc.)
- Aircraft worth \$619.4 million (includes 3 C-9s, 8 C-21s, 11 KC-135E)
- Equipment worth \$91 million
- Inventory worth \$14.5 million
- Total Value of Scott AFB Resources: \$3,611,818,419

## Economic Impact of Scott AFB in the Region (from the FY03 Scott Economic Impact Analysis):

Scott AFB has a \$1.63 billion impact (includes base payroll, base expenditures, estimated dollar value of indirect jobs):

- Payroll: \$970 million
- Annual Expenditures: \$412 million
- Construction of \$42 million
- Materials, equipment and supplies: \$190.8 million
- Services: \$112 million
